From the Parish Priest

Dear Parishioners,

On behalf of the Brisbane Oratory in Formation community, thank you to all those who supported the *Vallicella* dinner last Saturday and the major raffle for the necklace which was won by Mr Brian Kilmartin. Overall it was a great result as we have reached our target to fund our four seminarians through another year of their studies for the priesthood. Many thanks for your marvellous generosity and support which is greatly appreciated.

There is also some sadder news on the Oratory front to report. Last Wednesday night the following announcement was released on social media:

Following some months of stress and ill-health, Fr Paul Chandler is taking extended leave. Towards the end of June he will be moving from the Oratory for three months to assist in a parish in another diocese. During this time of rest and recovery, he will be supported both spiritually and practically by the Oratory Community.

In this time of formation for the Brisbane Oratory, the Fathers considered it advisable that a Moderator be in residence. Thus, Fr Paul has resigned as Moderator and a new Moderator has been elected. The new Moderator is Fr Adrian Sharp, who assumes the office this day, May 25th, for a term of three years.

Please note there will need to be only one change at the moment to the Mass and confession schedule while Fr Chandler is away on extended leave. **From Saturday 11th June confessions will be from 7:15am to 8:00am and Mass will begin at 8:15am.**

Next Friday 3rd June is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Immediately after both the 7:00am and 9:00am Masses that day there will be the public recitation of the act of reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. A plenary indulgence is attached to this recitation for the solemnity under the usual conditions.

As you know Mary Immaculate Church is a Seat of Mercy for this Jubilee Year of Mercy. The Door of Mercy however is, unfortunately, often locked for security and traffic noise reasons. Therefore, we have now shifted the formal Door of Mercy to the side door of the school side of the church. This is the door which is most often used and accessible during the week, as well as on weekends.

Our Reflection for this week on Corpus Christi follows:

We now return, in our meditation, to the Eucharist, which will soon be at the centre of our liturgical assembly and subsequent solemn procession. **In it, Jesus anticipated his sacrifice, not a ritual sacrifice, but a personal one. Jesus, in the Last Supper, moved by the "eternal spirit" with which He will then offer Himself on the Cross (cf. Heb 9:14), acts. Giving thanks and praise, Jesus transforms the bread and wine. It is Divine love, which transforms: the love with which Jesus accepts in advance the act of giving all of Himself to us. This love is nothing but the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of the Father and the Son, which consecrates the bread and wine, and changes their substance into the Body and Blood of the Lord, making present in the Sacrament the same sacrifice that takes place cruelly on the Cross.**

We may therefore conclude that **Christ was the real and effective priest, because he was full of the strength of the Holy Spirit, was filled with the fullness of God's love, and this, precisely, "in the night he was betrayed," precisely in the "hour of darkness" (cf. Lk 22:53). It is this divine power, the same power that realized the Incarnation of the Word, which transforms the extreme violence and extreme injustice into the supreme act of love and justice.**

This is the work of the priesthood of Christ, which the Church has inherited and carried through history, in the twofold form of the common priesthood of the baptized and that of ordained ministers, in order to transform the world with the love of God. Everyone, priests and lay faithful alike, are nourished by the same Eucharist, we all prostrate ourselves in adoration, for the Eucharist is present our Master and Lord, the true Body of Christ, Priest and Victim, the Salvation of the world. Come, let us exult with songs of joy! Come let us adore Him! *Amen.*

Gospel: *Luke 9:11-17*

Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and he cured those who were in need of healing. It was late afternoon when the Twelve came to him and said, 'Send the people away, and they can go to the villages and farms round about to find lodging and food; for we are in a lonely place here'. He replied, 'Give them something to eat yourselves'. But they said, 'We have no more than five loaves and two fish, unless we are to go ourselves and buy food for all these people'. For there were about five thousand men. But he said to his disciples, 'Get them to sit down in parties of about fifty'. They did so and made them all sit down. Then he took the five loaves and the two fish, raised his eyes to heaven, and said the blessing over them; then he broke them and handed them to his disciples to distribute among the crowd. They all ate as much as they wanted, and when the scraps remaining were collected they filled twelve baskets.
